### GENERAL GIFTS

Most legacy donors leave gifts that can be used wherever the funds are most needed. These gifts are incredibly valuable because they help us to respond to God's leading amid changing circumstances, while also safeguarding the core functions of the College. —

## SPECIFIC GIFTS

### To make a gift for a specific purpose:

If the Regent College 2000 Foundation Board determines at a future date that it is no longer possible, practical, or desirable to use my gift for the specified purpose, the Board may change its usage designation, bearing in mind the intent of this gift and the needs of the Foundation.

**Note:** The second paragraph in this example makes provision for unforeseen circumstances in which the donor's exact intentions cannot be accomplished in a way that would benefit the Regent community. This helps avoid unfortunate situations in which a donor's final gift cannot be used at all because the original conditions have become impossible to meet.

Including this kind of language ensures that your gift will bless Regent and its ministry in a lasting and meaningful way. Regent will always do its best to fulfill each donor's wishes—this includes honouring the intention of a gift as much as possible, even if the exact provisions need to be adjusted.
