Note: Regent College Foundation is registered with the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) organization. Donations to the Foundation are treated as charitable gifts for American taxpayers. GENERAL GIFTS

SPECIFIC GIFTS

Occasionally, donors prefer to leave specific instructions about how they would like a legacy gift to be used. If you have something specific in mind for your legacy gift, **please get in touch with us!** We'd love to help you express your intentions in a way that achieves your goals and maximizes the amount of good you can do for the Regent community.

To make a gift for a specific purpose:

I give the sum of \$_____ to Regent College Foundation (PO Box 33276, Seattle, WA 98133) for the purpose of _____.

If the Trustees of Regent College Foundation determine at a future date that it is no longer possible, practical, or desirable to use my gift for the specified purpose, the Trustees may change its usage designation, bearing in mind the intent of this gift and the needs of the organization.

Note: The second paragraph in this example makes provision for unforeseen circumstances in which the donor's exact intentions cannot be accomplished in a way that would benefit the Regent community. This helps avoid unfortunate situations in which a donor's final gift cannot be used at all because the original conditions have become impossible to meet.

Including this kind of language ensures that your gift will bless Regent and its ministry in a lasting and meaningful way. Regent College Foundation will always do its best to fulfill each donor's wishes—this includes honouring the intention of a gift as much as possible, even if the exact provisions need to be adjusted.
